description		Aesthetics of the New Danish Cinema (90's)
	Doctoral project description	For several years now, Nordic cinema has received great recognition on the international scene, regularly winning prestigious awards at film festivals. Danish cinema, represented by such names as Thomas Vinterberg, Lars von Trier or Nicolas Winding Refn, is making a major contribution to this success. The popularity of these directors is the result of the generational revival of the Danish film industry at the beginning of the





		1990s, encouraged by the revision of Danish film funding policies in 1989. This thesis aims to study this new dynamic in Danish cinema of the 1990s, looking both at the conditions that made the renewal of the Danish cinematographic scene possible, but also at the aesthetics of the films of this period. We'll be looking at the common themes and figures in these films, which seem to be particularly marked by young people's difficulties in finding their place in a Danish society in crisis. The Dogma 95 movement, founded by Lars von Trier and Thomas Vinterberg, characterized by its rejection of a cinema of illusion in favor of a cinema of the instant, is the best-known and most significant example of the broader dynamic that came together under the label of "New Danish Cinema".
