	Doctoral project description	This PhD project focuses on the production of verb polysemy (the property of a word having multiple meanings) in French-speaking children. We are interested in three groups of children: those with typical language

		<p>development (TLD), and those with atypical language development (ALD), either with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) or with semantic-pragmatic disorder (SPD). To our knowledge, this research will be the first in psycholinguistics to examine the production of verb polysemy in children speaking French.</p> <p>The aim is to analyze what characterizes the productions of these three groups of children; to examine the differences in their language use, as well as any commonalities that may emerge. We will also specifically study the influence of parental language on the emergence of verb polysemy in children.</p> <p>This thesis will provide speech-language pathologists and healthcare professionals with new insights into the language of these children.</p> <p>The analysis will be based on data drawn from recordings of everyday situations that are as diverse as possible, in order to encourage a wide range of verb uses.</p>
